Stat. §8.18</b>.          The purpose of the convention is for each party to nominate one presidential elector from each of Wisconsin's eight congressional districts and two electors from the state at large.</p> <p><a href="https://www.archives.gov/federal-register/electoral-college/electors.html">https://www.archives.gov/federal-register/electoral-college/electors.html</a>          Political parties often choose Electors for the slate to recognize their service and dedication to that political party.
