

ACTION: Get Su Voces es su Vos art from Eloisa for T-SHIRTS ● T-shirts are very important for canvassing - they can tell who you are in a non-threatening way. Latinx community is fearful of strangers and will avoid you unless your brand comes first - at least right now.
